Class & Lesson Policy

Registration	There is a \$30 Registration Fee per family.
Tuition	<p>Tuition is due on the 25th of every month and each payment covers 4 weeks of lessons. <i>For a breakdown of the payment schedule, please visit the website or ask at the office.</i></p> <p>There will be a \$10.00 late fee for any payments not received by the 1st of the month and a \$25.00 charge for any returned checks.</p>
No Deduction Or Refund Clause	There will be no deductions or refunds for missed classes, regardless of the reason for absence. Credit may be given for long-term illness or injury, and is based on sole discretion of the owners. There are no refunds or transfers. We appreciate your cooperation on paying in full.
Attendance	Consistent and prompt attendance is critical. Absences and tardiness can hold back an entire class, or hinder your individual progress. If you cannot attend your class or lesson for any reason, please email or call the studio prior to your scheduled time.
Make-Up Classes	<p>DANCE: In the event of an absence, a student may attend a make-up class (schedule permitting) any time from September - March. The make-up class must be arranged with the office ahead of time. (If a class is full, the make-ups may be done virtually.)</p> <p>VOICE: If a voice teacher cancels, a make-up lesson will be scheduled. If a student misses, he/she should make-up in the monthly Sight-Singing/Ear-Training Class.</p> <p><i>A schedule of these classes is available at the office.</i></p>
Inclement Weather Procedures	In the event that the studio must close, the outgoing voicemail message will be changed, an email will go out, and our social media pages will be updated. If you are in doubt, be sure to call the studio.
Variety Show Participation	Participation in the Variety Show is NOT mandatory, but encouraged! We do our best to work around conflicts, but once the Show Breakdown is distributed, students must be available for ALL of his/her scheduled performances AND for the MANDATORY dress rehearsal the weekend prior to the show in order to perform. (Be SURE to look at the studio calendar and let us know about dress rehearsal/performance conflicts ASAP- conflicts are worked around on a first-come, first-served basis) Costume Fees (which are minimal at Gateway To The Arts) and Tuition must be paid in full in order to perform in the Variety Show.

To maintain capacity levels, parents and siblings will not be permitted in the studio until otherwise notified.

Dress Codes & Requirements

Please be sure you read and understand our class requirements.

Students who disregard the dress code

WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASS.

They will be asked to sit and watch for that day.

<p>Requirements for Kids' Voice Class, Acting, A Cappella, and Private Lessons</p>	<p><u>A three-ring binder is required, and should be brought to EVERY CLASS/LESSON, as well as a sharpened pencil!</u></p> <p>Private Voice students are strongly encouraged to obtain a recording device. This can be a digital recorder, or a recording app now found on most phones and iPods. This will really help assist in students' practice habits.</p>
<p>Acting and Kids' Voice Class students will not be permitted to wear street shoes inside the dance studios.</p>	
<p>Attire/Supplies for Broadway Kids and Performer's Prep Classes</p>	<p><u>A three-ring binder is required for 1st grade and up, and should be brought to EVERY CLASS.</u></p> <p>Kids must wear comfortable clothing that they can move in. No skirts, dresses or tight jeans are permitted. All girls should have hair pulled away from their face.</p> <p><u>Black jazz shoes are required for all Broadway Kids classes.</u></p> <p>Performer's prep students should wear dance shoes- no street shoes will be permitted in the studio. Jazz shoes, half-soles, or foot undeez are required.</p>
<p>Attire for Dance Classes (Ballet/Tap/Jazz)</p>	<p><u>PRE-SCHOOL BALLET/TAP CLASS:</u></p> <p>All girls enrolled in ballet/tap MUST wear a leotard and tights to class. We ask that the dance outfit be simple. One or two colors, no designs or prints. Pink or Tan dance tights are required. (no shin-length leggings or stockings, please.) Their hair must be secured neatly away from their face, and no jewelry will be permitted. The only skirts that will be permitted are those that are attached to the leotard. All girls should have black tap shoes (no ties!) and pink ballet shoes.</p> <p><u>GIRLS (ALL DANCE CLASSES):</u></p> <p>Leotard: One or two colors, no designs or prints. <u>This applies to all classes.</u> Ballet skirts are permitted for Ballet class. No half-tops, please!</p> <p>Tights: Tan, Black, or Pink Tights are required for all ballet, tap, & jazz classes. No nylons or any other colored tights, please. Leggings are not permitted. <u>Girls must wear dance tights.</u></p> <p>Jewelry: No jewelry is allowed (rings, necklaces, bracelets, or watches). Small earrings are allowed.</p> <p>Warm-Ups: Warm-ups (sweats, shorts, athletic pants, etc) are permitted in all classes other than Ballet; However, the teacher may ask for these outer items to be removed, in order to properly address body position and alignment. <u>Therefore, a leotard and tights must be worn AT ALL TIMES</u></p> <p><u>PLEASE REMEMBER-</u> the use of warm-up clothes is strictly at the teacher's discretion!!</p> <p><u>BOYS (ALL DANCE CLASSES):</u> T-shirt and dance pants or shorts (sweat pants are ok, as long as they are not too baggy.) Tights are suggested for ballet, but not required.</p> <p><u>ADULTS:</u> Please wear clothing that you feel comfortable in, but be sure the teacher is able to see alignment and positioning.</p>
<p>Attire for Acro Classes</p>	<p>Bare feet are required. Students must wear body suits or bike shorts-- no baggy clothes! Stirrup or Footless tights are recommended.</p>
<p>Hair for Dance and Acro Classes</p>	<p>Girls' hair MUST be pulled back off face in either a bun or ponytail, and should be secured tightly to avoid distraction during class. If hair is too short to secure up, please use headbands or clips to ensure that hair is away from face. A Bun may be required for Ballet Classes. (at teacher's discretion)</p>
<p>Attire for Hip-Hop Classes</p>	<p>Comfortable baggy clothing. Sneakers or jazz sneakers are recommended. Soiled sneakers will not be permitted in the dance studio. Please check with your teacher for further details.</p>
<p>Footwear for Dance Classes</p>	<p>Ballet: Girls: Pink Ballet Slippers with elastic SEWN ON. Boys: Black Ballet Shoes with elastic SEWN ON, or Black Bloch Jazz Shoes.</p> <p>Tap: For Pre-School and Combo Classes, Black Tap Shoes are required. (For girls, no tied bows, please! Elastics, Velcro or Buckles Only) All other classes, Black or Tan Tap Shoes are permitted. (Black tap shoes are almost always required for performance)</p> <p>Jazz: Tan Bloch Jazz Shoes are recommended. Half-soles, foot undeez, and black jazz shoes are also permitted.</p> <p>Contemporary: Half-soles, foot undeez, ballet shoes, and jazz shoes are permitted.</p>

We all know how expensive dance shoes can be, and we know how quickly children outgrow shoes!
Be sure to look through our "Shoe Donation" bin at the studio, to see if someone has donated shoes that might fit you or your child.
Have old dance shoes? Please consider donating them to the GTA Shoe Donation Bin.

We strongly encourage all dancers to purchase a dance bag for shoes, binders and ballet skirts.

COVID POLICIES AND PROCEDURES, as of July, 2020:

- As per the state-wide mandate, all students and teachers will be required to wear a mask when inside the building.
- Class sizes will be limited, to accommodate social distancing, and to adhere to capacity limitations.
- To adhere to capacity limitations, parents and siblings will not be permitted inside the studio.
Drop-off should be done on Broadway (a teacher or staff member will meet younger students outside.)
Pick-up should be done at the back door, in the municipal parking lot (1st ave entrance.)
(a teacher or staff member will walk younger students to their parents.)
- For the time being, group classes will end approximately 5-minutes early, to facilitate sanitizing and pick-up/drop-off.
- If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID, the studio will be strictly virtual for 2 weeks (maintaining the same class schedule.) - **Positive cases will remain confidential.**
- If a student or staff member is EXPOSED to COVID, he or she will need to stay out of the studio for 2 weeks.
- Students who test positive or are exposed will notify the studio ASAP. Again, both types of disclosures will remain confidential.
- We will have a zoom option available for ALL classes, to join us from home when not in the studio.
- In the event of a mandated shut-down, we will return to a virtual schedule. Based on enrollment, we reserve the right to make minor adjustments to the schedule.
- Older students will be allowed to remain at the studio during breaks on a limited capacity, based on first-come, first-served request, and will adhere to all indoor mandates.

PRICING, as of July, 2020: Our registration fee for 2020 will be \$30 per family.

Our tuition prices have not increased, unless you are only enrolling in Private Voice Lessons.

ALL OF OUR CLASSES AND LESSONS RUN IN 4-WEEK SESSIONS

COST OF ACTING AND MUSICAL THEATRE CLASSES:

Broadway Kids/Performers Prep - \$80/session;

Tween & Teen Acting - \$70/session;

Kids Acting, Pee-Wee Acting, & Pre-Broadway Kids - \$65/session

DANCE/ACRO CLASS COSTS:

Our Dance classes run on sliding scales, based on number of hours. There are also sibling discounts:

COST OF PRIVATE VOICE LESSONS:

If a student is only enrolling in voice lessons, the cost is as follows:

½ hour - \$145 per 4-week session; 45-minute - \$205 per 4-week-session; 1 hour - \$275 per 4-week-session

For students enrolling in voice lessons in addition to ANY other classes, the cost is as follows:

½ hour - \$130 per 4-week session; 45-minute - \$190 per 4-week-session; 1 hour - \$250 per 4-week-session
